- Hands-on training
- Fundraising

Junior Members are <u>not permitted</u> to do the following activities:

- Participating in live structural firefighting exercises
- Using gasoline, hydraulic, or air powered tools
- Using high-pressure hose lines
- Using hose lines greater that 1-3/4 inches in diameter
- Using Self-Contained Breathing Apparatus (SCBA) in a dangerous atmosphere such as smoke and hazardous materials
- Rappelling or using ropes to raise or lower a person
- Extricating a person from a vehicle using hand or power tools
- Raising an object with airbags
