Police identify driver in Sykesville single-vehicle collision

Howard County police are continuing to investigate a single-vehicle collision that occurred at approximately 4:00 p.m. in Sykesville.

A silver Ford sedan was traveling on Route 32 northbound near the Carroll County line when it left the roadway and struck a pole.

The driver, Carl Patrick Wiley, 36, of Washington, DC, was transported to the University of Maryland Shock Trauma Center and is currently listed in serious but stable condition.

The passenger, a six-month-old, was transported to Howard County General Hospital for a check-up.

Preliminary investigation has revealed that the Ford left the roadway, for an unknown reason at this time, and struck a telephone pole. No other vehicles were involved.

One lane of Route 32 northbound and the northbound shoulder were closed for approximately two and a half hours while HCPD's Traffic Enforcement Section investigated.
